Version 9.3.0 Release Memo

We are pleased to announce the release of STEPLogic Warehouse Version 9.3.0. There is 20 new features and 44 bugs corrected. STEPLogic Warehouse 9.3 has new features such as:

- Allows Single Sign-on using SAML 2.0 for all Web Authentication
- Multi-Step Move Features in all outbound processing
- GDPR and "Right to be Forgotten" capabilities as recommended by third-party expertise
- New methods of Picking including "Batch Picking" based on configuration or by customized formulas
- SAP Connector Compliance with Outbound Processing
- Reengineered transactional apps for faster processing of outbound shipments
- New FileWriter Capabilities to build flat files with new configuration features
- Improved control by setting work limits matched to task types
- Ability to short ship an order

STEPLogic Warehouse is a software application to manage and track the receipt, inventory and shipment in the warehouse. It includes administrative support to configure and customize the solution for clients, and a user-friendly interface for running daily operations.

All product phases have been completed in accordance with the Körber Supply Chain LLC quality and system development life cycle policies and procedures.

- 47685: [Containerization] Containerization creating multiple pick tasks for 1 container instead of task content records

- 46892: [Cycle Counting] Erroneous discrepancy type "DIMENSION" created when ending cycle count
- 46915: [Cycle Counting] Error when finding stock in a Warehouse empty location and accepting that count result
- 47637: [Interfaces] Cannot manually load documents via Transactions due to the constraint error on the HOST DOCUMENT NO field
- 47250: [Interfaces] Order by configuration needs skipped as an included output field in the joins and xmlElements
- 46853: [Login Screen] Login showing duplicate companies/sites when employee has access to more than one
- 47672: [Picking] WD Pick by LP: App not finding location when LP remaining picks are only those that have been skipped due to shortage

- 47553: [Wave Processing] Waving not able to release more than one user created pick task

Installation Notes

- STEPLogic 9.2 or higher is required to be installed prior to installing Warehouse.
- For upgrades, please refer to section 7.1.4 of the STEPLogic (core) Installation manual to ensure security vulnerabilities are mitigated
- The following STEPLogic Apps have been obsoleted by this version:
 - SCHEDULED MOVE
 - COMPLETE TASKS UTILITY
 - INCOMPLETE TASK OVERVIEW
 - ALL_TASKS
- STEPLogic Connector FileWriter has three new company settings
- A new "client" package used for exit points has new functions which will need to be added to the body

 - "is_lp_format_invalid" To verify that an LP check is valid when an operator scans for a generic LP in receiving and outbound processing
 - "pick_task_release" to be used for wave release processing

Special Note on Screen Grid Sorting/Searching by Date

When identifying a column with a type of DATE, there have been several issues related to prior versions of STEPLogic. Some dates include time and others do not. The STEPLogic engine will now convert these CHAR values back to a DATE when searching or sorting, which means they will search and sort correctly. If you would like to do your own "custom" date/time columns in a Screen, you can still do that by identifying the column in Screen Builder as CHAR and not a DATE.

For it to function as expected we need two things in the Screen Builder configuration.

- 1. The column Type in Screen Builder must be set to DATE.
- 2. The SQL query must convert the DATE column to a CHAR using one of our two STEPLogic date settings(examples below).

One format has only the date(FORM_DATEPICKER_FORMAT) and the other has both a date and time(FORM_DATE_FORMAT). So, use either one depending on your needs.
